

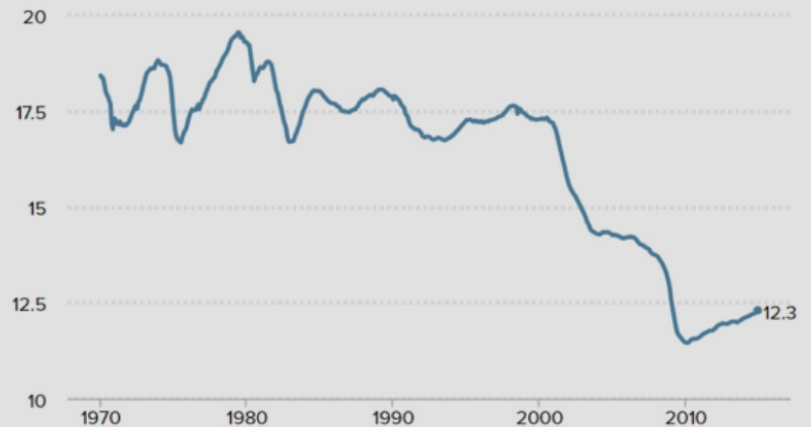
# MANUFACTURING AND JOB LOSSES IN THE UNITED STATES

The manufacturing industry is one of the largest industries within the economy

## Manufacturing Workers in the U.S.

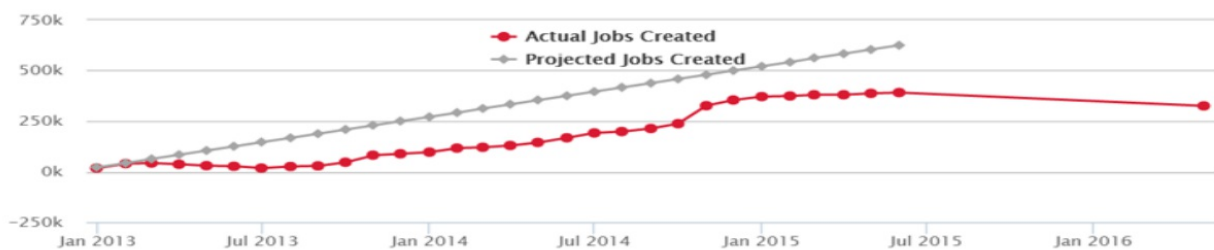
- 12.3 million workers
- 9% of the total workforce
- 800,000 hires since Recession

## THE GREAT RECESSION



U.S. lost 5 million manufacturing jobs between January 2000 and December 2014

**Real manufacturing output fell 10.3% between 2007 and 2009**

Only about 900,000 of the 2.3 million manufacturing jobs lost during the Great Recession have been recovered



## ECONOMY AND MANUFACTURING

In 2015, manufacturing contributed to over \$2.17 trillion to the U.S. economy

Manufacturing output has increased by almost 30% since 2009, however, the number of manufacturing jobs is smaller than it once was

2009: 12.561 million workers  
 2016: 12.3 million workers
