








800,000 hires since Recession

# THE GREAT RECESSION

Real manufacturing output fell 10.3 % between 2007 and 2009

Only about 900,000 of the 2.3 million manufacturing jobs lost during the Great **Recession have been** recovered









### ECONOMY AND MANUFACTURING

In 2015, manufacturing contributed to over \$2.17 trillion increased by almost 30% to the U.S. economy
